UPEC Local 792 Stewards are the face of the Local Union. Stewards are those who are employed in a bargaining unit represented by UPEC Local 792 and are appointed by the Local Business Manager. Stewards are the "go-to" person in the workplace and is one who has knowledge of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and the Local Union. Stewards may provide advice and assist members in resolving their issues.

Requirements

Must be a member in good standing with UPEC Local 792. A member in "good standing" is a member who works within a UPEC represented bargaining unit, current on their dues, has the respect and trust of fellow workers and is appointed by the UPEC Local 792 Business Manager.

Stewards must complete a minimum of eight (8) hours of UPEC Steward Training.

Other than the eight hours of training there are no mandatory amount of hours that must be accomplished. Member meetings are generally one to two hours a month.

Responsibilities

Communication is the most important job of our stewards. Keeping members informed of events and meetings.

Advising and assisting UPEC staff to enforce the MOU, workplace rules, safety and policy.

Welcome new members and provide information about the union and assisting in new member orientation.

Attend and participate in scheduled member and Steward Council meetings.
