Dear Mr. Darker and Mr. Lewis:

We have a valid petition to represent the Sacramento County Data Processing Unit 028 and a signature petition from the United Employees of California. We also have a valid intervening petition without a signature petition from the Stationary Engineers Local 39.

Following discussion with both organizations, we agree that the current Sacramento County Data Processing Unit 028, minus two positions of Information Technology Analyst assigned to the Board of Supervisors, is an appropriate unit for representation. The two positions of Information Technology Analyst assigned to the Board of Supervisors will be transferred to Confidential Employee Unit 070.

This notification commences the 15 day period for Stationary Engineers Local 39 to acquire the ten percent (10%) showing of interest required for their intervening petition.

In the mean time we will make efforts to schedule a meeting with a representative of the California State Mediation and Conciliation Service to prepare for a representation unit election.
